SPRA COMMITTEE MEETING 21 JANUARY 2020

KEY POINTS

Parking in the SPRA area

The preliminary results of the consultation survey in the SPRA area yielded a low response rate and the overall result is thought to be far too inconclusive for the City Council to wish to proceed with any sort of residents only parking scheme. The position will be clarified when the final analysis of the results is complete.

Accidents at the Five Lamps Junction

The City Council is to proceed with the erection of additional traffic signals at the junction (and alteration to phasing of the lights), as mentioned in the Key Points from the 25 November 2019 SPRA committee meeting. The SPRA committee will pursue this further if progress is not being made soon as there has been yet another similar accident in recent weeks.

'Deep Cleaning'

The City Council intends to carry out the above exercises in the SPRA area, with particular focus on road gutters and gullies. For this to be effective, parked vehicles have to be kept clear to allow the cleaning machines access. Residents can always report problems with particular gullies to StreetPride, but it would help if the complainant can assist in keeping the gully clear of parked vehicles when the work is to be carried out.

'Councillors on Patrol'

The Ward Councillors are hoping to find a date for one of their periodic 'walkabouts' in the area in February or March. The SPRA committee will assist with publicity and hopes that SPRA members will join in on the day, raising issues of local concern.

2020 SPRA AGM

The SPRA committee is currently finding a date for the AGM in late March or April, which, it is hoped, will be held once again in the main hall at the S. Mary's Parish Centre on Darley Lane.

The committee is now down to four members, which really is not enough, so we are looking for at least two more volunteers to come and join us. **Do give this some thought!**
